

**BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK
SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
HELD ON MAY 17, 2010**

A Special Meeting of the Municipal Council of the Borough of Woodland Park was held in the Mayor's Conference Room in the Municipal Building, 5 Brophy Lane, on May 17, 2010 and was called to order by Mayor Pat Lepore at 6:10 PM.

Present: Council President Kazmark (phone), Councilman DiDomenico, Councilman Spinelli, Councilwoman Gatti, Councilwoman Pascrell, Councilman Vargas and Mayor Lepore

Absent: None

Albert Buglione, Municipal Attorney, was present.

Mayor Lepore stated that in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Law P.L. 1975 c.231, notice requirements for this meeting were set forth detailing the time and place, with notice given to the public by posting a copy thereof on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building and transmitting copies to the Mayor, members of the Council, Officers and to The Herald News of Woodland Park.

PUBLIC HEARINGS:

Mayor Lepore opened the meeting to the public and asked if anyone wished to be heard.

Scott Rixford, Superintendent of the Woodland Park School System, asked whether or not the Woodland Park School Budget would be discussed at this meeting.

Mr. Andy Chabra of the West Paterson First Aid Squad stated that he is filing a grant application on behalf of the squad and needed statistical land use data to complete his application.

There being no one else wishing to be heard, the Public Hearing was closed.

The Mayor stated that the Woodland Park School Budget would not be discussed at this special meeting and that that subject will be addressed at the regular meeting on Wednesday, May 19th.

The Mayor stated that he would attempt to assist Mr. Chabra in securing the data that he needs to file his grant application.
