

**BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK
SPECIAL MEETING OF THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL
HELD ON FEBRUARY 29, 2016**

A Special Meeting of the Municipal Council of the Borough of Woodland Park was held in the Mayor's Conference Room in the Municipal Building, 5 Brophy Lane, on February 29, 2016 and was called to order by Mayor Keith Kazmark at 6:00 p.m.

Mayor Kazmark stated that in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Law P.L. 1975 c.231, notice requirements for this meeting were set forth detailing the time and place, with notice given to the public by posting a copy thereof on the bulletin board in the Municipal Building and transmitting copies to the Mayor, members of the Council, Officers and to The Herald News of Woodland Park where it was advertised on February 18, 2016.

PUBLIC HEARINGS:

Mayor Kazmark opened the meeting to the public and asked if anyone wished to be heard.

There being no one wishing to be heard, the Public Hearing was closed.

REVIEW OF 2012 BUDGET:

Mayor Kazmark gave a brief synopsis of the 2016 Budget.

Steve Wielkotz, Borough Auditor and Ann Purzycki, Borough Treasurer presented the 2016 proposed municipal budget to the Mayor and Council, which is scheduled to be introduced on March 2, 2016. Mr. Wielkotz provided his analysis on the impact on the taxpayers; description of the significant increases and decreases; and projections for the 2016 budget.

Ms. Purzycki articulated the Police and DPW contracts and their step increases.

Mayor Kazmark reviewed the 2016 Budget line by line and answered questions asked by the Council.

Steve Wielkotz, Borough Auditor provided an analysis of the debt services.

Ms. Purzycki articulated all the cuts that were made within the 2016 Municipal Budget as well as requested items from each of the departments.

The Mayor, Council discussed the 2016 Municipal Budget.

There being no further business to come before the Council, upon Motion by Councilman Spinelli, seconded by Councilman Holloway and unanimously passed on roll call vote, the meeting was adjourned at 7:28 p.m.
