**ORDINANCE No. 08-03**

**ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON LOWER  
NOTCH ROAD, LINCOLN LANE AND McBRIDE AVENUE WITHIN THE  
BOROUGH OF WEST PATERSON**

**PARKING—GENERAL REGULATIONS**

**(a) Violations of any Parking Regulations :**

Any violation of the specific prohibitions set forth in this Ordinance subjects the offender to the penalties established by the Borough of West Paterson (to be determined).

**(b) Effectiveness—**

- a.) This ordinance shall take full effect immediately after its final passage and publication as provided by law. Any individual, entity, corporation, or business who violates any of these provisions.
- b.) All other Ordinances of sections or provisions thereof which may be in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- c.) If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

**LOWER NOTCH ROAD**

Parking of any vehicle shall be prohibited on Lower Notch Road in the following area:

Along the east curb line. In addition, there shall be a parking limitation of 2 hours along the west curb beginning from the Little Falls town line and extending north to Lackawanna Avenue. The woods side will be the east side.

**LINCOLN LANE**

Parking of any vehicle shall be prohibited in the following manner on Lincoln Lane:

No parking Monday-Friday along the east curb line from Overmount Avenue to the C.O. School property line between the hours of 7:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. In addition, there shall be no parking between the hours of 2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. while school is in session.

**McBRIDE AVENUE**

Parking of any vehicle shall be prohibited at all times on McBride Avenue in the following area:

Along the east curb line of McBride Avenue from Dowling Parkway north 100 ft.

**REVOCAATION:**

All Ordinances and provisions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are thereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**VIOLATIONS:**

Any motor vehicle operator who violates the provisions of this Ordinance will be fined \$50.00.

If any motor vehicle operator is found to have violated this Ordinance and refuses to pay the same, his or her driving privileges may be suspended by a Court of competent jurisdiction.
