ORDINANCE No. 08-06

**ORDINANCE WHICH SUPERSEDES ORDINANCE NO. 07-22
TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON OVERMOUNT AVENUE,
ZURCHER'S LANE AND BRIARWOOD COURT
WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF WEST PATERSON**

PARKING—GENERAL REGULATIONS

(a) Violations of any Parking Regulations :

Any violation of the specific prohibitions set forth in this Ordinance subjects the offender to the penalties established by the Borough of West Paterson (to be determined).

(b) Effectiveness—

- a.) This ordinance shall take full effect immediately after its final passage and publication as provided by law. Any individual, entity, corporation, or business who violates any of these provisions.
- b.) All other Ordinances of sections or provisions thereof which may be in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- c.) If any provision of this Ordinance or the application of such provision to any person or circumstance is declared invalid, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance which can be given effect, and to this end, the provisions of this Ordinance are declared to be severable.

ZURCHER'S LANE

Parking of any vehicle shall be prohibited at all times on Zurcher's Lane in the following area:

From Rifle Camp Road 170 Feet East along the Southbound curb line.

OVERMONT AVENUE

Parking of any vehicle shall be prohibited at all times on Overmont Avenue in the following area:

From the Northeast curb line beginning at driveway of 153 Overmont Avenue and extending 265 Feet East along Northeast curb line .

BRIARWOOD COURT

Parking of any vehicle shall be prohibited at all times on Briarwood Court in the following area:

From Southeast curb line of Briarwood Court and Browertown Road and extending 440 Feet along the Southeast curb line.

REVOCATION:

All Ordinances and provisions that are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and are thereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

VIOLATIONS:

Any motor vehicle operator who violates the provisions of this Ordinance will be fined \$50.00.

If any motor vehicle operator is found to have violated this Ordinance and refuses to pay the same, his or her driving privileges may be suspended by a Court of competent jurisdiction.
