ORDINANCE NO. 08-12

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER XI OF THE ORDINANCES
OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST PATERSON, WHICH IS ALSO KNOWN
AS THE “TRAFFIC ORDINANCE” TO INSTALL A STOP SIGN ON THE
SPUR OF MT. PLEASANT AVENUE**

WHEREAS, Chapter XI, Section 11-8, Schedule VIII of the Ordinances of the Borough of West Paterson which is known as “Traffic Ordinance” names stop intersections; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of West Paterson seeks to have cars heading north on Browertown Road and exiting onto the northbound one-way spur of Mt. Pleasant Avenue come to a full stop prior to entering onto Mt. Pleasant Avenue;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of West Paterson as follows:

I. Chapter XI, Section 11-8, Schedule VIII of the Ordinances of the Borough of West Paterson, shall be and is hereby amended as follows:

II. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

III. If any section, paragraph, subdivision or provision of the subsection shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the paragraph, subdivision clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the subsection shall be deemed valid and effective.

IV. This Ordinance being vital to the public health, safety and welfare shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication provided by law.
