

# **BOROUGH OF WEST PATERSON**

## **ORDINANCE 08-15**

### **AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER IX OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF WEST PATERSON WHICH IS KNOWN AS “LICENSING OF DOGS” ORDINANCE ADOPTED DECEMBER 29, 1972 AS AMENDED**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Municipal Council of the borough of West Paterson, in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey, as follows:

#### **SECTION I**

That Section 9-2.5 of an Ordinance of the Borough of West Paterson entitled “Licensing of Dogs”, adopted December 29, 1972, as amended, be further amended and supplemented to read as follows:

**9-2.5 FEES.** The person applying for a license shall pay a fee of \$10.00 for each dog. He shall also pay \$1.50 for the State of New Jersey registration tag for each dog and the fee set by State Statute for the Pilot Clinic Fund and Animal Population Control Fund. The same fees shall be charged for the annual renewal of each license and registration tag.

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance will be fined \$100.00.

#### **SECTION II**

All other Ordinances or Sections or provisions thereof which may be in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

#### **SECTION III**

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.
