

# **BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK**

## **ORDINANCE 09-01**

### **AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER IX OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK WHICH IS KNOWN AS “LICENSING OF DOGS” ORDINANCE ADOPTED DECEMBER 29, 1972 AS AMENDED**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Municipal Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey, as follows:

#### **SECTION I**

That Section 9-2.5 of an Ordinance of the Borough of Woodland Park entitled “Licensing of Dogs”, adopted December 29, 1972, as amended, be further amended and supplemented to read as follows:

**9-2.5 FEES.** The person applying for a license shall pay a fee of \$10.00 for each dog. He shall also pay \$1.00 for the State of New Jersey registration tag for each dog and the fee (\$0.20) set by State Statute for the Pilot Clinic Fund and Animal Population Control Fund (\$3.00). The same fees shall be charged for the annual renewal of each license and registration tag.

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance will be fined \$100.00.

#### **SECTION II**

All other Ordinances or Sections or provisions thereof which may be in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

#### **SECTION III**

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.
