

BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK

ORDINANCE 09-03

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER XIII OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK WHICH IS KNOWN AS “UTILITIES ORDINANCE” ADOPTED 12/29/72 AND AMENDED ON 12/4/74, 9/14/77, 6/11/80, 12/16/81, 3/27/85, 3/9/88, 1/89, 2/90, 2/93, 7/96, 3/01 AND 4/07.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Municipal Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION I

That Sections 13-8.1 and 13-8.2 of an Ordinance of the Borough of Woodland Park entitled “Utilities”, adopted December 29, 1972, and amended on 12/4/74, 9/14/77, 6/11/80, 12/16/81, 3/27/85, 3/9/88, 1/89, 2/90, 2/93, 7/96, 3/01 and 4/07 shall be further amended and supplemented to read as follows:

13-8.1 WATER CONSUMPTION RATES: Minimum quarterly charges, dependent upon the size of the meter through which service is provided shall be made for each meter as follows:

5/8 inch meter	\$ 44.00 per quarter
3/4 inch meter	\$ 66.00 per quarter
1 inch meter	\$ 112.00 per quarter.
1 1/2 inch meter	\$ 221.00 per quarter
2 inch meter	\$ 354.00 per quarter
3 inch meter	\$ 997.00 per quarter
4 inch meter	\$1,581.00 per quarter
6 inch meter	\$3,162.00 per quarter

The rate for all water consumed shall be \$2.77 per 100 cubic feet of water.

13-8.2 FIRE SERVICE LINES: A minimum quarterly charge shall be made for each fire service line as follows:

4 inch	\$ 365.00 per quarter
6 inch	\$ 641.00 per quarter
8 inch	\$1,139.00 per quarter
10 inch	\$1,880.00 per quarter
12 inch	\$2,562.00 per quarter

For the purpose of determining Fire Service Line, pipe size measurements shall be made where the private line connects to the municipal system. In the event the private Fire Service Line is connected to the municipal system in more than one location and services a single realty improvement, only one Fire Service charge shall be assessed. That charge shall be based on the size of the largest connection to the municipal system.

MUNICIPAL FIRE HYDRANT FEES: A minimum quarterly charge shall be made for each fire hydrant as follows: \$57.50.

SECTION II

Said rates as set forth in Section I above shall become effective on the first day of January, 2009.

SECTION III

All other ordinances or sections or provisions thereof which may be in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as provided by law.
