

**BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK
ORDINANCE NO. 10-04**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER XI OF THE ORDINANCES OF
THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK, WHICH IS ALSO KNOWN AS
THE “TRAFFIC ORDINANCE” TO INCLUDE A PENALTY FEE.**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodland Park hereby adopts this ordinance, to amend Chapter XI of the Ordinances as to the Borough of Woodland Park, which are also known as the Traffic Ordinances.

Specifically, through this Ordinance, vehicles will no longer be permitted to park on the West and East sides of Newby Avenue, from the intersection of McBride Avenue and Newby Avenue, for a distance of 170 feet on the Western side of the street, and for a distance of 50 feet on the Eastern side of the street.

WHEREAS, all other provisions of the Woodland Park Traffic Ordinances, and New Jersey State Statutes regarding parking, will still be in full effect, and are not hereby amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey as follows:

I. Chapter XI of the Ordinances of the Borough of Woodland Park, which are known as the Traffic Ordinances, which allow parking on the west and east side of Newby Avenue, to the intersection of McBride Avenue are hereby amended as follows:

“Parking will no longer be permitted or allowed on the West side of Newby Avenue from the intersection of McBride Avenue for a distance of 170 feet; and parking will no longer be permitted or allowed on the East side of Newby Avenue from the intersection of McBride Avenue for a distance of 50 feet”.

II. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

III. If any section, paragraph, subdivision or provision of the subsection shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the paragraph, subdivision clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the subsection shall be deemed valid and effective.

VIOLATION:

Any motor vehicle operator who violates the provisions of this Ordinance will be fined Fifty-Five (\$55.00) Dollars.

If any motor vehicle operator is found to have violated this Ordinance and refuses to pay the same, his or her driving privileges may be suspended by a Court of competent jurisdiction.

II. All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

III. If any section, paragraph, subdivision or provision of the subsection shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the paragraph, subdivision clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the subsection shall be deemed valid and effective.
