**ORDINANCE No. 10-09**

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER XI OF THE ORDINANCES  
OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK, WHICH IS ALSO KNOWN  
AS THE “TRAFFIC ORDINANCE,” TO PROHIBIT PARKING ALONG THE  
FRONTAGE OF 1030 MCBRIDE AVENUE LISTED IN THE TAX MAP AS  
BLOCK 99, Lots 9.01, 10, 11 and 12.**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough of Woodland Park hereby adopts this ordinance, to amend Chapter XI of the Ordinances as to the Borough of Woodland Park, which are also known as the Traffic Ordinances.

Specifically through this Ordinance, vehicles will no longer be permitted to park on the street in front of the properties located at 1030, 1034 and 1040 McBride Avenue, which are listed in the Borough Tax Map as Block 99, Lots 9.01, 10, 11 and 12.

**WHEREAS**, all other provisions of the Woodland Park Traffic Ordinances, and New Jersey State Statutes regarding parking, will still be in full effect, and are not hereby amended.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**I.** Chapter XI of the Ordinances of the Borough of Woodland Park, which are known as the Traffic Ordinances, which allow parking on the street in the area of 1030 McBride Avenue in front of Block 99, Lots 9.01, 10, 11 and 12 are hereby amended, as follows:

“Parking will no longer be permitted or allowed on the street in the area of 1030 McBride Avenue in front of Block 99, Lots 9.01, 10, 11 and 12, which shall include 5 feet west of the said location.”

**VIOLATION:**

Any motor vehicle operator who violates the provisions of this Ordinance will be fined Sixty (\$60.00) Dollars.

If any motor vehicle operator is found to have violated this Ordinance and refuses to pay the same, his or her driving privileges may be suspended by a Court of competent jurisdiction.

**II.** All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**III.** If any section, paragraph, subdivision or provision of the subsection shall be adjudged invalid, such adjudication shall apply only to the paragraph, subdivision clause or provision so adjudged and the remainder of the subsection shall be deemed valid and effective.
