**Commingle Curbside pick-up:** Place commingles in appropriately marked 35 gallon container. Decals are available at Recycling Center or Department of Public Works (DPW) offices. Do NOT place commingled materials in plastic bags. These items can also be brought to the Recycling Center.

**Commingled Items:**

<b>Glass:</b> This does NOT include plate glass, light bulbs, window glass, Pyrex, cookware, dishes, drinking glasses, cups or mirrors.	<b>Plastic:</b> Only plastic bottles that have #1 or #2 stamped in the recycle triangle on the bottom. Does NOT include toys, empty containers from any oil products, Rubbermaid or buckets.	<b>Tin and Aluminum:</b> Items do not include Aluminum foil, cookware or aluminum food containers.

**APPLIANCES/SCRAP METAL** – Schedule Curbside pick-up or drop off at Recycling Center.

**REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS/AIR CONDITIONERS** – Curbside pick-up or drop off at Recycling Center – \$5.00 Sticker is required...purchase Sticker at either Municipal Clerk’s Office, DPW or Recycling Center.

**TIRES AND AUTO BATTERIES** – Resident must bring to Recycling Center – Tires have a \$2.50 fee per tire, which must be free of rim. Auto Batteries are accepted with no fee. Proof of Residency is required.
