**Commingle Curbside pick-up:** Place commingles in appropriately marked 35 gallon container. Decals are available at Recycling Center or Department of Public Works (DPW) office. Do NOT place commingled materials in plastic bags. These items can also be brought to the Recycle Center.

**Commingled items:**

<b>Glass:</b> This does NOT include plate glass, light bulbs, window glass, Pyrex, cookware, dishes, drinking glasses, cups or mirrors.	<b>Plastic:</b> Only plastic bottles that have #1 or #2 stamped in the recycle triangle on the bottom. Does NOT include toys, empty containers from any oil products, Rubbermaid or buckets.	<b>Tin and Aluminum:</b> Items do not include Aluminum foil, cookware or aluminum food containers.

**Cardboard/Newspaper** - Curbside pickup needs Cardboard broken down, and tied in bulk and Newspaper needs to be put into brown grocery bags or bound/tied up. Then put recyclables to curb. Both can be brought to Recycling Center.

The **Department of Public Works (DPW)** will schedule SPECIAL pick-ups of Metal and small appliances.

Call the DPW office AT 973-256-1264 to schedule.

**APPLIANCES/SCRAP METAL-** Schedule Curbside pick-up or drop off at Recycling Center.

**REFRIGERATORS/FREEZERS/AIR CONDITIONERS-** Curbside pickup or drop off at Recycling Center- \$5.00 Sticker is required...purchase Sticker at either Municipal Clerks Office, DPW or Recycling Center.

**TIRES AND AUTO BATTERIES** – Resident must bring to Recycling Center – Tires have a \$2.50 fee per tire, which must be free of rim. Auto Batteries are accepted with no fee. Proof of Residency is required.

**MOTOR OIL** – Resident must bring to Recycling Center – limit of one (1) gallon that is NOT contaminated with other fluids. Proof of Residency is required.

**ELECTRONICS** – NJ State Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) Regulation as of January 2011 requires ALL ELECTRONICS to be recycled. NO curbside pickup for TV’s, computers, monitors, etc. These items must be brought to the Recycling Center and disposed in the designated container.

**GRASS/BRUSH/LEAVES Pickup Schedule**

Beginning with the first Monday in April through the first Monday in December, vegetation collection of Grass/Brush/Leaves will be picked up weekly. This vegetation must be collected in BIO-DEGRADABLE BAGS and, if for any reason a container/plastic bag/garbage can is used, there will be NO collection. Brush is to be tied in bundles not to exceed 4 foot in length or 3 foot in width with a total weight of no more than 50 pounds. Tree branches with a diameter of 4 inches or larger are excluded. At any given time, a resident may deliver this material to the Recycling Center.

The following **Monday Holidays** will have no Grass/Brush/Leaves pick up: May 29<sup>th</sup> & September 4<sup>th</sup>.

**Note:** Tree Stumps, logs, pallets or railroad ties are NOT ACCEPTED at the Recycling Center.

**NJ DEP** Regulations stipulate Grass/Brush/Leaves must be placed in Bio-Degradable Bags.

Bio-Degradable Bags are available to purchase for 50 cents per bag at any of the following sites:

**CHRISTMAS TREES** – Put your tree curbside for DPW to pick up through the 3<sup>rd</sup> week of January. Ensure the tree has no wire/lights attached or is not wrapped in plastic.

**ALL Tuesdays and Fridays are available for Garbage pickup.**

**SPECIAL NOTES:**

- Earliest placement or a curbside pickup is 3:00PM the day BEFORE scheduled pickup.
- Garbage and/or Recycles **MUST BE** curbside NO LATER than 5AM of scheduled collection day.
- Items **NOT EVER ACCEPTED** at Recycling Center:
  - Propane tanks/solid waste including garbage, tree stumps, logs, pallets, concrete, cinder blocks, bricks, railroad ties or any construction debris.
