ADOPTION OF BOROUGH ORDINANCE NO. 14-3

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK, WHICH IS KNOWN AS THE “TRAFFIC ORDINANCE” TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, desires to adopt an ordinance entitled; **AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK, WHICH IS KNOWN AS THE “TRAFFIC ORDINANCE” TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK**; and

WHEREAS, notice of introduction and passage on first reading was published in The Herald News dated January 27, 2014, setting the date of February 5, 2014 for the public hearing and consideration for final passage; and

WHEREAS, copies of the ordinance were posted on the Borough’s official bulletin board and copies made available to all those desiring same; and

WHEREAS, in compliance with State Statute, a public hearing on the above referenced ordinance was conducted on January 22, 2014 at the regularly scheduled meeting of the Mayor and Council;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the ordinance entitled **AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CHAPTER VII OF THE ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK, WHICH IS KNOWN AS THE “TRAFFIC ORDINANCE” TO REGULATE THE PARKING OF COMMERCIAL VEHICLES WITHIN THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK** be and is hereby adopted as having been approved on second and final reading, and the Municipal Clerk be and he is hereby authorized and directed to publish said Ordinance according to law
