MOTORCYCLE RUN FUNDRAISER**

**WHEREAS**, the Save The Animals Rescue Team (START), a non-profit organization that raises funds to pay veterinarian bills and food costs for homeless animals, has notified the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, that they intend to hold their 6<sup>th</sup> Annual Ride To Rescue Motorcycle Run on Sunday, June 22, 2014 beginning and ending at the Great Notch Inn in Little Falls and travel through several other Passaic County towns; and

**WHEREAS**, START has established the Ride to Rescue route, which includes roadways within the boundaries of the Borough of Woodland Park; and

**WHEREAS**, the New Jersey State Department of Transportation now requires that each municipality involved in the route provide written approval for the participants to transverse through is municipal roads on June 22, 2014 for this event; and

**WHEREAS**; this request was reviewed by the Woodland Park Police Chief and it is his recommendation that such approval should be provided by the Woodland Park Mayor and Council;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey hereby acknowledge the efforts of Save The Animals Rescue Team and authorize the participants in this Motorcycle Run to transverse its municipal roads on June 22, 2014, as long as all participants are in total compliance with all State and Local laws and that said participants will follow directions and orders given by all authorized law enforcement officer.
