RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SETTLEMENT OF
TAX APPEALS REGARDING BLOCK 111, LOT 16.14
AS SET FORTH ON THE OFFICIAL TAX MAP OF
THE BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK IN
REGARD TO PROPERTY OWNED BY
KHALID ABDALLA

WHEREAS, Khalid Abdalla is the owner of the property located at 730 Rifle Camp Road, in Block 111, Lot 16.14 as set forth on the official tax map of the Borough of Woodland Park, and who has filed an appeal with the Tax Court of the State of New Jersey bearing Docket No. 017788-2012 from the assessed values of said property for tax year 2012; and

WHEREAS, the parties have agreed that the 2012 assessments will be reduced to a total of \$570,700, and that the Freeze Act will not apply for tax years 2013 and 2014; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has agreed to take the proposed refund as a result of this settlement in the form of a credit to be applied first to delinquent taxes due and owing, if any, and then to successive tax bills due immediately following the issuance of the judgments; and

WHEREAS, the property owner has further agreed to waive statutory pre-judgment interest; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Tax Assessor, Borough Appraiser and Tax Counsel have agreed to the reduction in value on the property for the 2012 tax year in accordance with the settlement; and

WHEREAS, the settlement results in an approximate total tax refund for the tax year 2012 in the amount of \$1,927.50, all of which will be applied as a credit against future taxes; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Council for the Borough of Woodland Park has determined that it is in the best interests of the Borough to adjust the assessments on the aforesaid property for tax year 2012 in accordance with the settlement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of Woodland Park in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The tax assessments on the property located at 730 Rifle Camp Road designated as Block 111, Lot 16.14 on the official tax map of the Borough of Woodland Park shall be reduced a total of \$570,700 for 2012 only, as the Freeze Act will not apply to 2013 and 2014.

2. The Borough Tax Collector is hereby authorized to credit the proposed refund of \$1,927.50 to successive tax bills upon issuance of the Tax Court Judgment attributable to the reduction in the assessments for the 2012 tax year.

3. This Resolution shall take effect immediately or as otherwise provided by law.
