RESOLUTION R14-195**

**7 VALLEY DRIVE BLOCK PARTY**

**WHEREAS;** the resident located at 7 Valley Drive, Woodland Park, New Jersey has requested the Mayor and Council’s approval for the closure of Valley Drive between Grandview Drive and Highview Drive; and

**WHEREAS;** the resident of 7 Valley Drive, Woodland Park, New Jersey have set the time and date of this gathering to be Saturday, August 16, 2014 between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m. on said day, and

**WHEREAS;** the resident of 7 Valley Drive, Woodland Park, New Jersey accept the conditions under Ordinance 99-16, Section 6-2 Noise and will abide by the NO public use of alcoholic beverages provision; and

**WHEREAS;** the Woodland Park Borough Department of Public Works shall affix “Emergency No Parking” signs on Valley Drive between Grandview Drive and Highview Drive; and

**WHEREAS,** movable barricades will be placed on Valley Drive between Grandview Drive and Highview Drive which shall be positioned for ease of access and/or removal for emergency vehicles under the direction of Chief Anthony Galietti, Woodland Park Police Department, and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, in the County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, hereby approve a block party at 7 Valley Drive between Grandview Drive and Highview Drive as set forth in this resolution subject to the following conditions:

1. The roadway may be blocked off by barricades, but must remain clear for any emergency vehicle traffic.
2. No rides, games of chance, tables, grills of any kind, etc. shall be set up in the roadway (curb to curb)
3. No consumption of alcohol beverages shall be permitted in public pursuant to Ordinance 07-08.
4. No vehicle shall be used to block off the roadway.
5. All local ordinances will apply during the event.
6. The Police Department has the right to cancel this event at any time if the above conditions are not adhered to or if the Police Department deems anything as being unsafe.
