DE-SILTING AND DE-SNAGGING OF
THE PASSAIC RIVER**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council, of the Borough of Woodland Park and the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Totowa, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, have jointly applied for a New Jersey State Department of Environmental Protection (NJDEP) grant for the de-silting and de-snagging of the Passaic River; and

WHEREAS, the municipalities have been advised that a grant in the amount of \$150,000.00 has been awarded by the NJDEP for the referenced project; and

WHEREAS, the administrative staff of the Borough of Woodland Park has agreed to be the lead agency to administer this grant;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, on behalf of itself and the Borough of Totowa accept this NJDEP grant in the amount of \$150,000.00 for the de-silting and de-snagging of sections of the Passaic River; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Kevin Galland, Borough Administrator is hereby authorized to execute all documents relative to this matter.
