RESOLUTION R14-240**

**EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION
DEMOLITION OF HOMES ON BERGEN BLVD. AND WEST 35TH STREET**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, adopted Resolution R14-224 on August 20, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services will not approve Resolution R14-224, due to the fact that the Resolution is for a Special Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Local Government Services will approve a Resolution for a Regular Emergency; and

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen with respect to the Demolition of Properties Condemned by the Construction Code Official and no adequate provision was made in the 2014 budget for the aforesaid purpose; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-46 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above mentioned; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of emergency appropriation(s) created including the appropriation to be created by this resolution is one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) and three percent (3%) of the total operations in the budget for the year is four hundred fifty nine thousand two hundred nineteen dollars (\$459,219.00),

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, that in accordance with N.J.S.A 40A:4-48 that:

1. An emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for the amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00).
2. That said emergency appropriation shall be provided in full in the 2015 budget.
3. That the Chief Financial Officer has certified that the expenditures to be financed through this resolution are related to the aforementioned emergency.
4. That an "Emergency Note" not in excess of the above amount be authorized pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-48 and in accordance with the provision of N.J.S.A 40A:4-51.
5. That said note shall be executed by the Chief Financial Officer and by the Borough Clerk.

6. That said note, may be renewed from time to time and such note and any renewals thereof shall be payable on or before December 21, 2015.
7. That two (2) certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of Local Government Services.
