

**BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK
PASSAIC COUNTY, NEW JERSEY
RESOLUTION R14-252**

**EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION
IN-GROUND FUEL TANK**

WHEREAS, an emergency has arisen with respect to the deterioration of the gasoline and diesel fuel tanks at the Department of Public Works Yard and no adequate provision was made in the 2014 budget for the aforesaid purpose; and

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A 40A:4-46 provides for the creation of an emergency appropriation for the purpose above mentioned; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of emergency appropriations(s) created including the appropriation to be created by this resolution is five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00) and three percent of the total operations in the budget for the year is four hundred fifty nine thousand two hundred nineteen dollars (\$459,219.00);

WHEREAS, the foregoing appropriation together with prior appropriations exceeds three percent of the total current appropriations (including utility operating appropriations in the budget for 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, (not less than two-thirds (2/3rds) of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring) that in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:4-49 petition be made to the Director of Local Government Services for permission to exceed the statutory limitation of 3% for the creation of an appropriation for the purpose stated above in accordance with the following:

1. An emergency appropriation be and the same is hereby made for in the amount of three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000.00).
2. That said emergency appropriation shall be provided in full in the 2015 budget and/or funded through the adoption of a Bond Ordinance to finance said purpose.
3. That the Chief Financial Officer has certified that the expenditures to be financed through this resolution are related to the aforementioned emergency.

4. That the statement required by the Local Finance Board has been filed with the Clerk and a copy thereof will be transmitted to the Director of Local Government Services.

5. That two (2) certified copies of this resolution be filed with the Director of Local Government Services.
