RESOLUTION R14-282**

**EMERGENCY PURCHASE
FUEL TANKS
DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS**

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2014 (R14-253), the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic and State of New Jersey declared a Declaration of Emergency to address the failure of the fuel tanks at the Department of Public Works, 1 Browertown Road, when it was determined by the appropriate regulatory agencies that the outer wall of the gasoline tank had been compromised; that the tank can no longer be used for its intended purpose; that the tank is a potential environmental hazard; and that this tank requires removal and replacement in an expeditious manner; and

WHEREAS, since both tanks (gasoline and diesel) are in the same location and are of the same age and deterioration, it is necessary to remove and replace both tanks simultaneously; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council has authorized the Borough Administrator and the Director of Public Works to address this emergency in the most cost effective and efficient manner, securing quotes for work where practicable and making direct purchases without quotes where necessary, in order to reduce the environmental impact which might result from this emergency condition; and

WHEREAS, a quote has been secured to remediate this emergency condition from Salomone Brothers, 17 Demarest Drive, Wayne, NJ 07470-6744, in the amount of \$249,850.00;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey hereby award a contract in an amount not to exceed \$275,000.00 to Salomone Brothers, 17 Demarest Drive, Wayne, NJ 07470-6744, for the removal and replacement of two fuel tanks located at the Department of Public Works, 1 Browertown Road, Woodland Park, NJ.
