**CONTRACT AWARD
DEMOLITION OF 106 BERGEN BLVD.
CDBG-DR**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Woodland Park received a grant of Federal Community Development Block Grant-Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds through the New Jersey Department of Community Affairs and the County of Passaic to be used for the purpose of acquiring and demolishing flood-prone residential property near the Passaic River; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is in the process of completing the process to have the targeted homes demolished; and

WHEREAS, the Borough did issue a bid on July 22, 2015, with a return date of August 4, 2015, to have the structure located at 106 Bergen Blvd. demolished under the referenced Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) Grant; and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2015, four (4) bids were received by the Borough Administrator with the results as follows:
