WHEREAS, it has been determined that the desired truck is available under the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council (MCCPC) of which the Borough of Woodland Park is a member; and

WHEREAS, said vehicle is available for purchase from the MCCPC’s successful vendor, Route 23 Automall, LLC, 1301 Route 23, Butler, NJ 07405 for the purchase price of \$31,652.00 as follows;
