

**BOROUGH OF WOODLAND PARK

RESOLUTION R15-232**

**GRANT ACCEPTANCE
HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM - FEMA**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey desire to purchase and have installed two generators: one to be installed at the West Paterson Boys and Girls Club, Memorial Drive; and a second generator to be installed at the Charles Olbon School, 50 Lincoln Avenue, both located within the Borough of Woodland Park; and

WHEREAS, Mr. George Galbraith, Superintendent of Public Works, had made application to the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management (NJOEM), P.O. Box 7068, West Trenton, NJ 08628, for a grant for the purchase and installation of the two generators; and

WHEREAS, as a result of Mr. Galbraith's efforts, the municipality has been advised by the NJOEM that the municipality has been awarded a grant in an amount not to exceed of \$129,600.00 for the purchase and installation of the two generators; and

WHEREAS, the municipality acknowledges that at a minimum the municipality will be responsible for 10% of the costs associated with the purchase and installation of the two generators, which can be funded through in-kind services or cash as required;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, in the County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, do hereby accept the grant in an amount not to exceed of \$129,600.00 from the New Jersey Office of Emergency Management for the purchase and installation of two generators: one to be installed at the West Paterson Boys and Girls Club, Memorial Drive; and a second generator to be installed at the Charles Olbon School, 50 Lincoln Avenue, both located within the Borough of Woodland Park; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council authorize the Borough Administrator, Kevin Galland, to execute all documents relative to this matter.
