**COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK
GRANT-DISASTER RECOVERY
PURCHASE OF 14, 18 & 106 BERGEN BLVD.**

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council, of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, had applied for a Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) grant to fund the acquisition and demolition of residential properties on Bergen Blvd. and create open-space in perpetuity; and

WHEREAS, the Borough is in receipt of a grant in the amount of \$848,263.00 to fund this project; and

WHEREAS, the governing body had initially identified the properties of 14 and 106 Bergen Blvd. for acquisition and demolition of the structures on the property and the creation of open-space in perpetuity; and

WHEREAS, the governing body approved Resolution R15-183 on July 15, 2015, authorizing the Borough Attorney to: proceed with the acquisition of the properties known as 14 and 106 Bergen Blvd.; authorizing the Borough Attorney to execute all documents on behalf of the Borough of Woodland Park in this matter; and further authorizing the Borough Treasurer to issue the required checks for the acquisition of the properties; and

WHEREAS, now the Mayor and Council desire to acquire and demolish the residential property known as 18 Bergen Blvd.; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that the current owner of 18 Bergen Blvd., is Fannie Mae and is selling the property for the amount of \$75,000.00, which is less than the pre-storm appraisal of \$210,000.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, hereby amends Resolution R15-183 to include the location known as 18 Bergen Blvd. as a property to be acquired and demolished using the referenced CDBG-DR funds, and further authorizes the Borough Attorney to execute all documents on behalf of the Borough of Woodland Park; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Borough's Treasurer is hereby authorized to issue the check in an amount not to exceed \$75,000.00 for the acquisition of 18 Bergen Blvd.; and
