RESOLUTION R16-156**

**2006 BOND ORDINANCE
LINE ITEM REALIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2006, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park adopted Bond Ordinance 06-06 in the amount of \$1,750,000; and

WHEREAS, one of the purposes of the aforementioned Bond Ordinance calls for the repaving of Whitaker Avenue, Zoar Street and West 36th Street; and

WHEREAS, the Bond Ordinance allows for the listing of additional streets to be repaved if funds are available; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council desire to repave the following streets utilizing funds from the 2006 Bond Ordinance: Salomone Avenue; Hughes Place; Memorial Drive; Taft Avenue; Dowling Parkway, and portions of Mulroony Court; Vetrone Drive; Hromiak Terrace; Fillipone Way; Wallace Lane; and Lozrovich Place; and

WHEREAS, during the implementation of the various projects, it has been necessary to expend funds in amounts greater than anticipated in certain line items in that Bond Ordinance, which is permissible as long as the total amount of the bond ordinance is not exceeded; and

WHEREAS; it is necessary to document these expenditures through a resolution;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey does hereby approve the realignment of the 2006 Bond Ordinance as shown in the table below; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the total amount of the 2006 Bond Ordinance in the amount of \$1,750,000 has not been exceeded.
