**2007 BOND ORDINANCE
LINE ITEM REALIGNMENT**

WHEREAS, on July 18, 2007, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park adopted Bond Ordinance 09-06 in the amount of \$1,505,500.00; and

WHEREAS, during the implementation of the various projects, it has been necessary to expend funds in amounts greater than anticipated in certain line items in that Bond Ordinance, which is permissible as long as the total amount of the bond ordinance is not exceeded; and

WHEREAS; it is necessary to document these expenditures through a resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council did previously realign the anticipated expenditures in certain line items in the 2007 Bond Ordinance via R12-263;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED; that the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Woodland Park, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey does hereby approve the realignment of the 2007 Bond Ordinance as shown in the table below; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED; that the total amount of the 2007 Bond Ordinance in the amount of \$1,505,500.00 has not been exceeded.
