

I wish you and your loved ones a joyful holiday season and a healthy, prosperous New Year.



DO NOT bag recyclables!

A reminder to residents that recycling should not be put out in plastic bags, as it will not be collected by the hauler.

Residents should place commingled recycling out in any kind of plastic or metal can from 36 to 64 gallons.

Residents should not use 5-gallon buckets, milk crates or small used plastic containers

CARDBOARD & NEWSPAPER CURBSIDE PICK-UP

CARDBOARD should be broken down and left curbside. NEWSPAPERS are to be in cardboard box, paper bag or recycling bin.

DO NOT place cardboard & newspapers in plastic bags.

Cardboard & Newspaper

Items Include:

- Corrugated Cardboard
- Junk Mail
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Office Paper
- Paperback Books
- Paper Bags

Does Not Include:

Cardboard boxes that contain grease, cheese, crusts or wax paper liners are highly detrimental to the recycling process. So please, recycle only empty and clean boxes including pizza boxes.

If you want to, you can rip off and dispose of the soiled part and recycle the rest.

RECYCLE TIPS

Bottles/cans should be empty and rinsed clean

 Usually clear and used to make soda and water bottles

 Usually opaque found in milk jugs, cleaner containers, shampoo bottles and used to make pens, lumber, fencing and detergent bottles.

BRUSH & GRASS CURBSIDE PICK-UP

First Monday of April to the first Monday of December

NO PICKUP MAY 25th & SEPT. 7th

- Brush must be placed in BIODEGRADABLE BAGS.
- Tied in bundles not to exceed 4' in length or 3' in width
- Total weight of no more than 50 lbs.
- No branches with diameter of 4" or larger
- Place bags/bundles curbside after 3:00 pm on Sunday or No later than 5:00 am Monday morning
- Plastic bags will NOT be picked up curbside per the N.J.D.E.P.

HAZARDOUS WASTE

NOT ACCEPTED CURBSIDE OR RECYCLE CTR.

Items include; Pesticides, Herbicides, Pool Chemicals, Oil based Products, Fluorescent Bulbs, Fire Extinguishers, Propane Tanks and more.

SOLID WASTE CURBSIDE PICK-UP

Tuesday & Friday

Place solid waste/garbage curbside after 3:00 PM the day BEFORE scheduled pick up or NO later than 5:00 AM on the day of collection! CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS is NOT permitted in solid waste/garbage collection. These items must be removed by the contractor or homeowner.

Please follow proper curbside placement hours in order to reduce wind-blown garbage, animals getting into curbside garbage & to keep our borough looking clean!



VACANT HOME CHECKS

Going on Vacation? If you reside in Woodland Park, and will be planning time away from your residence, our patrol officers will conduct periodic checks on your home. These types of checks are unannounced, and consist of an exterior check of the residence. The officers will look for anything out of the ordinary, including criminal mischief, trespassing, open doors or forced entry. If you are interested in having your home listed on the department Vacation Home Log, complete the Residential Vacation Notification Form and return it to the Woodland Park Police Department front desk.

When calling to schedule an inspection, you must have the permit number and be specific in what you are requesting.

If you fail to arrange a final inspection, you will be in violation of NJAC 5:23 218D and will be subject to a monetary penalty of up to \$250.00/day for every day the violations remain outstanding.

***** Construction is prohibited on Sundays *****

RENTAL AND RESALE CERTIFICATE

All buildings and units that are leased, rented or the transfers of title, regardless of the term, are required to be inspected and receive an Existing Structure Certificate of Occupancy. A list of the most common reasons for failure will be given to you before the inspection during the application processes.

Inspection by building official consists of a visual review only. It is not a thorough, in-depth structural investigation of the dwelling.

A complete overview of the property can be obtained from a registered home inspection agency.

All rentals for 1, 2, or 3 family homes that were built prior to 1978 MUST comply with the New Jersey Lead Law. Inspections need to be done either with Lew Environmental or any other licensed Lead inspection company of your choice (fees apply for inspections). Certificate must be presented to the building department, and we will keep on file along with the Municipal Clerks office.

ORDINARY MAINTENANCE OR REPAIRS

Ordinary maintenance to structures may be made without filing a permit. If you are not sure if a construction permit is needed, please call the Borough of Woodland Park Building Department for assistance. The following is a list of the most common maintenance or repairs that do not require a permit:

1. Exterior and interior painting
2. Installation, repair or replacement of any interior finishes of less than 25 percent of any wall area in any one- or two-family dwelling.
3. Vinyl wall covering and wall papering is ordinary maintenance.
4. Paneling shall not be considered ordinary maintenance.
5. The replacement of glass in any window or door, existing window or door including garage doors, in its original opening. The replacement of bedroom escape windows and doors may be made in the same opening and shall not reduce the required height, width or net clear opening of the previous window or door assembly.
6. The repair or replacement of any non-structural member such as a partition railing, kitchen cabinets and exterior or interior trim
7. The replacement or installation of any flooring material in one- and two-family dwellings shall be permitted under ordinary maintenance.
8. The repair or replacement of existing roofing and siding material, other than polypropylene siding, on detached one- and two-family dwellings.
9. The repair or replacement of any part of a deck, porch or stoop that does not provide structural support for any roof or portion of a building. The construction or complete replacement of a deck requires a full permit
10. The installation of any roll or batt insulation when installed adjacent to or not more than one and a half inches from interior finish.
11. Replacement of exterior rainwater gutters and leaders.


