## Planning Board Minutes

Meeting Called to order at 7:30pm by Vice Chairman Tanski

A motion to approve the minutes of 6/4/18 was made by Mayor Kazmark, second by Ms. Van Dyk and approved. Minutes for 6/4/18 accepted.

### **Order of Business:**

Review Woodland Park Open Space and Recreation Plan.

The Plan was introduced by Chris Dochrey PP, ACIP of CME Associates who prepared the plan for the Borough. The Plan was last reviewed in 2007 and must be updated to apply for grants to continue upgrades to the Parks and open spaces. Future goals were discussed such as installing a Turf field at Zaccaria Park, extending the Morris Canal Park, coordinating the extension of the Dowling Park with the county, updating zoning in conjunction with the

Board of Education Conservation area and updating the area with new benches, picnic tables, improved lighting. Renovate Rifle Camp Park Nature Center, construction of Dog Park, exercise facility for the public, a new pavilion and playground. Resurface the playground at Rose Place Park. Replace fences at May Park.

In general, upgrades are proposed for all parks and playgrounds. The formula, determining the required Open Spaces, was discussed and Woodland Park exceeds the standard requirement.

The meeting was opened to the public. Comments received were to look into the possibility of creating a skating Park at Zaccaria Park. Making Zaccaria Park more multi-purpose. Opening the rest rooms on the weekends at Rose Place Park and including bike paths and pedestrian walks on future plans in Morris Canal Park.
