COMMINGLED CURBSIDE PICK-UP

Place commingles in an appropriately marked 35-gallon container. Decals are available at the Recycling Center or DPW Office.

DO NOT place commingled material in plastic bags.

Commingled items Include: Glass Containers, Plastics #1 and #2, Aluminum containers, Tin cans

Does Not Include:

- Aluminum foil & food containers
- Flowerpots, Garden Hoses
- Bubble Wrap & Styrofoam
- Light Bulbs
- Containers from any oil product
- Mirrors & Window glass
- Dishes, drinking glasses & cups
- Plate glass
- Hazardous Waste
- Pyrex & cookware
- Rubbermaid or buckets
- Toys

DO NOT bag recyclables!

A reminder to residents that recycling should not be put out in plastic bags, as it will not be collected by the hauler.

Residents should place commingled recycling out in any kind of plastic or metal can from 36 to 64 gallons.

Residents should not use 5-gallon buckets, milk crates or small used plastic containers.

RECYCLE TIPS

Bottles/cans should be empty and rinsed clean



Usually clear and used to make soda and water bottles



Usually opaque found in milk jugs, cleaner containers, shampoo bottles and used to make pens, lumber, fencing and detergent bottles.

CARDBOARD & NEWSPAPER CURBSIDE PICK-UP

CARDBOARD should be broken down and left curbside.

NEWSPAPERS are to be in cardboard box, paper bag or recycling bin.

DO NOT place cardboard & newspapers in plastic bags.

Cardboard & Newspaper Items Include:

- Corrugated Cardboard
- Junk Mail
- Magazines
- Newspapers
- Office Paper
- Paperback Books
- Paper Bags

Does Not Include: Cardboard boxes that contain grease, cheese, crusts or wax paper liners are highly detrimental to the recycling process. So please, recycle only empty and clean boxes including pizza boxes.

If you want to, you can rip off and dispose of the soiled part and recycle the rest.

BRUSH & GRASS PICK-UP April through December

First Monday of April to the first Monday of December

NO PICKUP MAY 26th & SEPT. 1st

- Brush must be placed in BIODEGRADABLE BAGS.
- Tied in bundles not to exceed 4' in length or 3' in width
- Total weight of no more than 50 lbs.
- No branches with diameter of 4" or larger
- Place bags/bundles curbside after 3:00 pm on Sunday or
- No later than 5:00 am Monday morning
- Plastic bags will NOT be picked up curbside per the N.J.D.E.P.

SOLID WASTE CURBSIDE PICK-UP Tuesday & Friday

Place solid waste/garbage curbside after 3:00 PM the day **BEFORE** scheduled pick up or **NO later** than 5:00 AM on the day of collection!

CONSTRUCTION DEBRIS is **NOT** permitted in solid waste/garbage collection. These items must be removed by the contractor or homeowner.

Please follow proper curbside placement hours in order to reduce wind-blown garbage, animals getting into curbside garbage & to keep our borough looking clean!

BULK WASTE

TWO PIECE LIMIT per pick-up

- Furniture, wood doors, tables
- Rugs -cut 4' length & tied
- Lumber-cut 4' length & tied
- Paint Cans- Water base ONLY & dried out
- Mattresses & Box Springs MUST be wrapped in plastic.

CHRISTMAS TREES PICK-UP Month of January

The DPW collects throughout the month of January.

Residents can also drop them off at the Recycling Center.

Please **REMOVE** all the ornaments, garland, lights

TREES CANNOT BE IN A PLASTIC BAG.

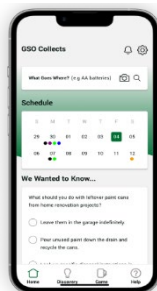
Computers, electronics, appliances and metal will not be picked up with your garbage. They must be brought to the recycling center and placed in appropriate containers or call the DPW Office at **973-256-1264** arrange for a curbside pick-up on bulky items

ITEMS ACCEPTED

- Air Conditioners - \$5.00 Fee for containing Freon
- Appliances and Scrap Metal – All metal items
- Cardboard and Newspaper – NO PIZZA BOXES
- Commingled – NO PLASTIC BAGS
- Grass and Brush – NO PLASTIC BAGS
- Electronics - TVs, computer monitors, printers/faxes
- Refrigerators - \$5.00 Fee for containing Freon
- Tires - Free of rims \$2.50 fee - Proof of residency required.
- Vehicle Batteries – No charge
- Motor Oil – Limit one (1) gallon and not contaminated with other fluids. Proof of residency.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Propane Tanks
- Solid Waste / Garbage
- Construction Debris
- Tree Stumps / Logs / Railroad Ties
- Pallets
- Concrete

Woodland Park is now accepting **CLEAN** Styrofoam packaging. **DROP OFF at the recycling center**

Acceptable: - Foam from TVs, appliances, electronics, furniture & foam coolers.

Not Acceptable: Packing Peanuts, Egg Cartons, Food Trays, Color Foam, Insulation Foam Panels & Flexible or Film Foam.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE
